The Civil Action Day Committee, which is organizing a non-violent sit-in in waves of twenty from 6 a.m. to 12 noon on October 16 at the Induction Center was organized last June to promote mass civil disobedience against the war in Vietnam. The group has already conducted three sit-ins there, at which 39 people have been arrested and jailed. The membership is varied, including clergymen, teachers, housewives, and students. The confused and frightened young men caught by the draft will be faced with stepping over our bodies as they will later have to walk over Vietnamese bodies. TURN IN DRAFT CARDS, Federal Building, 450 Golden Gate, S.F. For those interested in stopping the draft permanently. Without willing bodies there can be no draft and no war. For us, talk is not enough. We are compelled to make all our actions, the very courses of our lives conform with our commitment. We have to build a different future by being different people and living a different kind of life. On Oct. 16, hundreds of us across the country will turn our draft cards back to the

federal government. We do this as a gesture to make our existence known, to inspire others into taking the

same step. What we are building for is this:

To bring so many men to our position that the draft will grind to a halt.

On Oct. 16, we in the Bay Area will meet at the Federal Court Building in San Francisco. There we will have a rally and turn in our draft cards. 10 - 12 a.m., Oct. 16: Cars leaving for S.F. from Stiles Hall parking lot at the corner of Durant and Dana.

12 - 1 p. m.: Rally at the Federal Court Building, 450 Golden Gate, San Francisco 1 p. m.: Collect draft cards and hand over to the federal marshall.
