## BECAUSE WE KNOW THAT:

- a) SRI does chemical and biological warfare research (tear gas and crop defoliation).
- b) SRI has had 55 staff members doing counter-insurgency work in Thailand since 1962.
- c) SRI is performing cost analysis of alternative bombing sights over North Vietnam.
- d) SRI is doing long-range surveys of investment opportunities in Southeast Asia for US corporations.
- e) Many Stanford and SRI trustees are major executives of 1) war-based corporations such as McDonald Douglas, Hewlett-Packard, and General Dynamics, and 2) corporations with heavy investments in Southeast Asia such as Tenneco, Utah Construction, and Kaiser.
- f) Many Stanford faculty members consult for or serve as directors of nearby war-based companies, and serve on Defense Department subsidized advisory boards and committees.

## FURTHERMORE, WE DEMAND THAT:

- a) All contracts, both classified and unclassified, be made public, complete with information on the value of the contracts and the individuals performing the work.
- b) Stanford and SRI trustees make public all their corporate and governmental connections.
- c) Stanford faculty make public all their governmental and corporate contracts and connections.
