For the past six weeks the young people of the Peninsula have waged an ongoing struggle for the right of peaceful assembly at Liberation (Lytton) Plaza, in downtown Palo Alto. The movement began when the Midpeninsula Free University was denied their right to provide for young people in the area a community center.
