At a meeting of 1600 Stanford students and faculty, it was voted 3 to 2 to continue the occupation of the Applied Electronics Laboratory until there was an acceptable response to the demands formulated April third. They also decided to accept the following resolution:

We are profoundly opposed to the war-related research which is done at Stanford and at SRI, and also at the moral irresponsibility which the trustees exhibited so clearly in their inaction at their meetings. We have shown our opposition and outrage— and we are committed to the demands we presented more deeply than ever before. We therefore reaffirm our demands of April third, and further demand that the trustees act decisively to begin to meet these demands by Monday.

We are not pacified by the rhetorical posture assumed by the Board in their statement on Chemical and Biological Warfare, and we will not be pacified until our demands are met.
