Students supporting the occupation of AtE.L. voted overwhelmingly this afternoon to demand that the Trustees have an open decision-making meeting Monday and that decisions regarding the holding of A.E.L. be made pending the results of this Trustee meeting.

They also tabled the motion that the Academic Council meet by Tuesday because a guidlines committee had not yet set up a review board or carefully defined guidlines for research.

Students further voted support of the "struggle" in which students at Harvard and Radcliff are engaged.

It was announced that the Stanford <u>Daily</u> sent telegrams to 20 universities calling for students to examine research now in progress at their campuses. The telegrams also asked for expressions of support.

The following activities for the weekend at AEL are now being planned: A "rush party" Friday night in the AEL courtyard; a renaming ceremeny Saturday at noon for the XXX AEL building; a seminar Satruday afternoon, and a Faculty tea Sunday afternoon.
