- 1. Send a representative to the Senate Judicial Council Hearing today.

 The hearing is being held to determine whether we are violating the University Policy on Disruption.

 Failed
- 2. Send 15 people from the meeting to Peter Allan's office to pick up good copies of the SRI Committee Report to take to SRI employees.

 Passed.

THERE WERE NO VOTES ON THE REMAINDER OF THE PROPOSALS

- 3. We must increase the pressure of our demands to bring SRI under tighter control and to redirect SRI's research. The trustees are the key to control of SRI. Therefore, it was proposed that in order to inspire the trustees to act, we escalate in some manner.
- 4. Organize a faculty alliance which will educate the community about our movement.
- 5. Increase our work with the community.
- 6. Increase our work with SRI employees.
- 7. Pressure SEC (Student Educational & Manual Council) to demand that the Academic Senate consider SRI.
- 8. Establish a Research Review Board now to screen research done at AEL so that research which is approved by this board may resume.
- 9. Hold a General Strike of the University and dedicate the day of the Strike to forums and confrontations on the issues across campus.
- 10. Tour and talk to employees in other University buildings. Find out what they are doing.
- 11. Approach SRI as the Induction Center was approached with pickets and sit-downs, etc.
- 12. Have the University establish a Research Information Center to makes actively seek support of our research from non-military agencies and private foundations; to build a personal contacts necessary for such support; and to aquaint members of the academic community with domestic problems which fit their research interests. (Proposed by the Electrical Engineering Dept.)
