THE ISSUES

We demand that the trustees discontinue all plans for severance of SRI, and that instead SRI be brought into a closer relationship with the University, and that guidelines be established for socially acceptable research to be directly applied to SRI and the rest of the Stanford community.

We demand that all research in the following areas be stopped, and that no new contracts be accepted:

- Classified research
- Counterinsurgency--at home and abroad
- Chemical and Biological Warfare
- In support of the wars in Southeast Asia
