LYTTON PLAZA: Monday, at 8:00 PM, the Midpenisula Free University is sponsoring a public meeting at Lytton Plaza, corner of Emerson and University in Palo Alto. There will be a sound truck with open microphones. This is a community meeting. We must go to it and talk about Stanford's and SRI's relationship to Berkeley. We have been fighting CBW and counter-insurgency at Stanford and SRI, and now we have seen CS tear gas, similar to the tear gas produced by Hewlett's FMC, sprayed on hundreds of our brothers and sisters in Berkeley out of a helicopter nozzle most likely designed and developed by SRI. By severing SRI from the university, the Trustees tried to sever the issue from Stanford. But they have only made SRI, more than ever before, an issue which the Palo Alto Community must face and which Stanford must not forget.

WHITE PLAZA: Tuesday, at 12:00 noon, there will be a rally at White Plaza, followed by a march to Hoover Tower. At Hoover Tower we hope to have a chance to discuss the Berkeley issue with Glenn Campbell, who is director of Hoover Institute and a regent at Berkeley. We would like him to explain how the work that the Hoover Institute does relates to the situation at Berkeley. We would also like him to explain the ideology of the Senior Staff at Hoover Institute, almost all of whom were appointed by him. In case Mr. Campbell is not there, or will not talk to us, we would hope that another member of the Senior Staff would explain these things to us. A symbolic expression of our feelings concerning the relationship between Mr. Campbell and the situation in Berkeley is planned, and we're also trying to arrange for speakers from the surrounding community who have sound knowledge of the political and economic implications of Hoover Institute to join us there.
