I, Terence W. Denley, say and declare:


1. I am employed by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LELAND STANFORD JUNIOR UNIVERSITY as Associate General Secretary and Director of Administrative records.

Encina Hall contains the offices of the Secretary to the University, performing special functions under the direction of the President of the University; the Vice President for Business Affairs and his staffs, which staffs include the University Planning Office, Business Manager, Insurance Manager, Real Property Manager and the Personnel Office; the offices of the Controller and Director of Finance, which together are responsible for University budgets, disbursements, payroll, endowment accounting and other financial matters; the Office of the General Secretary, responsible for raising funds for the University; the Office of the News Service, which is responsible for all news releases issued by the University; as well as academic offices, business machines and equipment, records and service functions connected with all of the above.

2. On May 1, 1969, I entered Encina Hall on Stanford campus at approximately 9.15 am. At that time I observed in the Controller's office on the second floor that files had been entered, folders pulled out and folder contents scattered about the floor. At that time I further observed that the General Secretary's Office had sustained damage in the form of broken panes of glass, a missing electric typewriter, and other typewriters which were rendered inoperative by bending the keys.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true.
