I, Willard G. Wyman, say and declare:

1. I am employed by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LELAND STANFORD JUNIOR UNIVERSITY as Associate Dean of Students. In this capacity I am responsible for working with students in their extracurricular activities. I have been continuously employed since 1966 in this or similar capacities.

2. On May 1, 1969 at approximately 2:30 a.m., I accompanied Joel Smith into Encina Hall. He then announced over an amplifier to the people present that they were in violation of President Pitzer's emergency regulation concerning students participating in a sit-in, and that they would be given immediate, temporary suspensions if they did not leave the building within 15 minutes. I assisted him in requesting them to leave the building, and proceeded through the building making this request.

3. At approximately 3:05 a.m. on May 1, 1969 I again entered Encina Hall, this time accompanied by Professor Raymond E. Wolfinger, Mr. William L. Leland, Professor James F. Gibbons, Professor Thomas Ehrlich, Professor John W. Meyer, and others. In the building I observed John W. Avery, Richard S. Bogart, Fred H. Cohen, Arthur M. Eisenson, Jeanne T. Friedman, Barbara A. Goldie, Marc D. Heller, Kristin D. Hind, Michael M. Menke, Paul Rupert, James E. Shoch,

John F. Shoch, Guy D. Smythe, Don P. Stuart, Michael D. Vawter, and
Doron Weinberg.

4. At approximately 7:00 a.m., the Santa Clara County Deputies
and some faculty members entered Encina Hall; I observed that all of
the people in the building left within about 15 minutes.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true.
