

AFFIDAVIT OF CHARLES PAINTER

I, CHARLES PAINTER, say and declare:

1. I am a photographer for Stanford News Service.
2. On April 10, 1969, from approximately 8.00 am until approximately 5.00 pm I was at the Applied Electronics Laboratory, which is located on the principal academic campus of Stanford University. My purpose in being at this location was to photograph the events that were taking place both inside the Applied Electronics Laboratory and outside in the area surrounding the Applied Electronics Laboratory.
3. I was using a Nikon F camera with a 35 mm, f2 type lens. The lens was about 5 feet above the ground and I was using no filter.
4. I was using Tri X film, 36 exp size.
5. I personally took each of the photographs that are attached as exhibits to this Affidavit.
6. Exhibits 1 and 2 (negatives numbers 7007-5 and 7008-10) were taken at the Applied Electronics Laboratory. These photographs accurately represent the condition of the portion of the Applied Electronics Laboratory depicted therein as of the time such photographs were taken.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true.

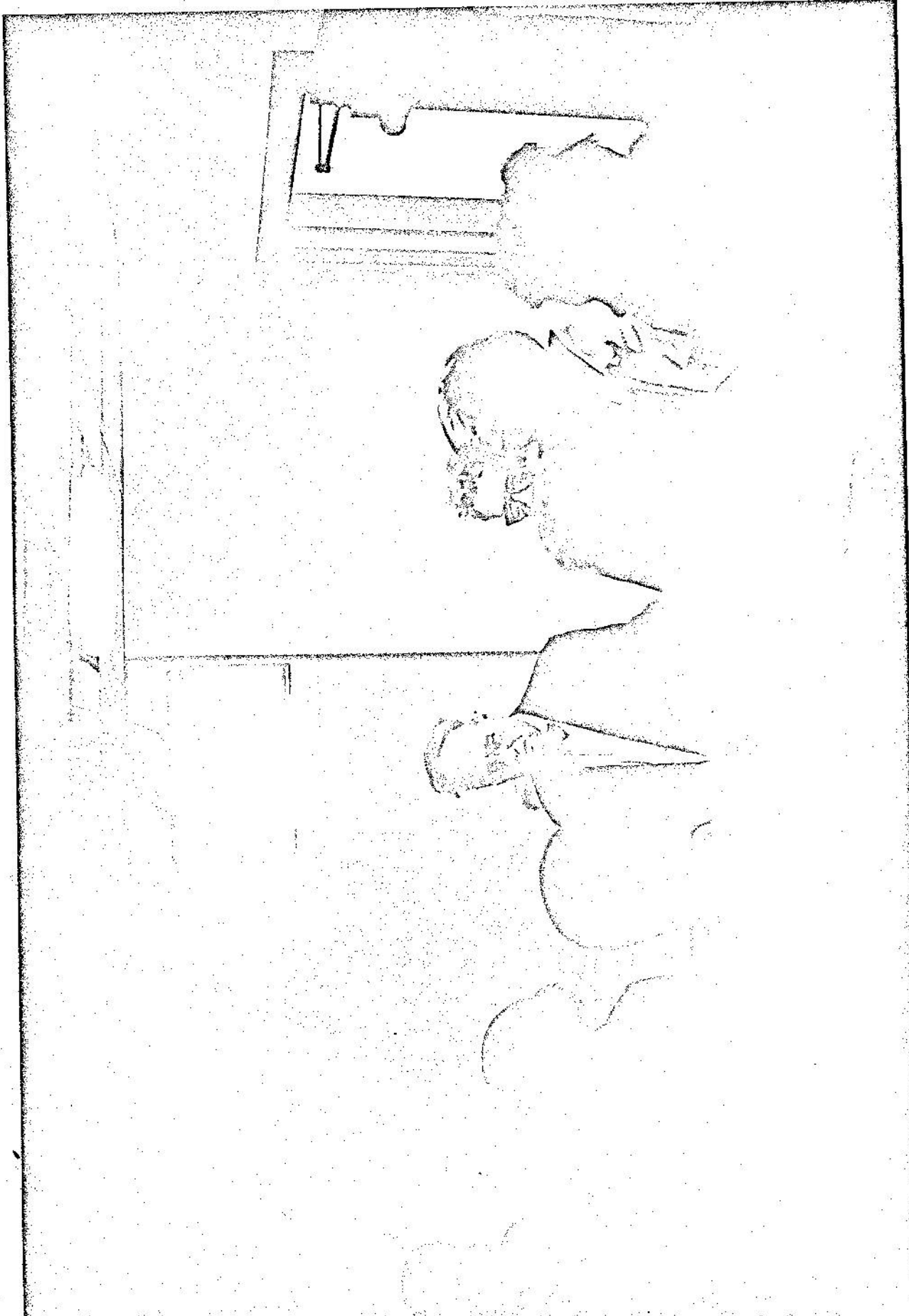
