I, FRANKLIN G. RIDDLE, say and declare:

1. I am employed by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LELAND STANFORD JUNIOR UNIVERSITY as an Associate Controller and Director of Financing Planning and Analysis at Leland Stanford Junior University. I have been continuously so employed since November 2, 1964 in this and similar capacities. In this capacity I am a University officer responsible for the financial aspect of budgeting, long range financial forecasting and financial analytical studies.

On April 13, 1969, I was appointed by the Provost of the University as a member of a group of interviewers responsible for entering the Applied Electronics Laboratory Building on Stanford Campus, requesting the identity of individuals occupying the building and, if such individuals would not identify themselves as being engaged in legitimate University business or research, to request them to leave.

2. I entered the Applied Electronics Laboratory Building on April 13, 1969 at approximately 1:30 P.M. and there observed defendant, MARY HANSEN, on the roof of the Applied Electronics Laboratory.

3. I entered the Applied Electronics Laboratory Building again on the afternoon of April 14, 1969 and requested various defendants to leave and, if they refused, asked them their names. No names were given and I did not recognize any defendant to which I could attach a name at that time.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true.
