Statement of: Michael M. Roberts

- I. I, Michael M. Roberts, am employed by the Board of Trustees of the Leland Stanford Junior University as Financial Operations Administrator and Director of Administrative Computing for the Controller. I have continually been employed in this or a similar capacity since June of 1965.
- II. In my present capacity I am responsible for the Accounting Operations and the Administrative Data Processing sections which are located in the basement, first floor and second floor of Encina Hall.
- On May 1, 1969, I entered Encina Hall at approximately 8 a.m. At that time I observed that in the Controller's area on the second floor, the Processing, Billing and Reporting area was in a state of great disarray. The tub file of budget statements was upended on the floor. Papers, ashes, and personal effects were scattered throughout the area. The glass in the door entering into this section was broken.
 - IV. Across the hall I observed that the glass in the door entering the Research Administration Office was also broken. The files and desks were disarranged and in confusion.
 - V. The glass in the door to the office of the Director of Finance was also broken.
 - VI. I also observed that the doors to the Planning and Analysis section had been opened. These doors are normally locked. However, there is an opening of approximately eighteen inches between the partition and the ceiling. Files and drawers in this area were opened and portions of the files missing. One typewriter in this section was inoperative because of mechanical damage.
- VII. Shortly thereafter I inspected my secretary's typewriter and the typewriter of the Controller's secretary; both of these had a bottle of soft drink poured into them and had to be removed for cleaning.
- VIII. I observed that the hallway in the second floor of Encina Hall was full of debris and furniture, spilled milk, cigarette ashes and coffee.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing statements are true.
