ENCINA RENAMED

At the first general meeting of the April 3 Movement in our new home, the group unanimously voted to rename the building, the Huey P. Newton ~~Institute~~ Institute for the Study of Racism, Imperialism, and Capitalism.

Also discussed at the meeting were the principles of conduct governing April 3 Movement participants during the occupation. First, there is to be no violence ~~toward~~ toward any person. Second, it was agreed that there are certain types of information in this building that in the interests of democracy and the free flow of information, should be made public. ~~These documents will be freed in the name of the people.~~

There was considerable discussion about what to do in case of a bust. It was agreed that we should move to prevent a bust by the tactic of the last "delicious moment" tactic, which means that after the cops come we gather for a general meeting to decide what to do. A general policy established was that all those who are on probation at the present time not get busted (that is that they leave at their own discretion in case of imminent bust)

In case that vigilantes try to break up our demonstration, it was agreed that our own people will guard the door at all times to prevent entry ~~on part of~~ ^{by} YAF's Jocks etc.

Because of the importance of keeping a large number of people it was agreed that send a statement of solidarity to Huey Newton rally not send our own delegation.
