

REPORT OF THE PEOPLE'S SUBCOMMITTEE ON INVESTIGATIONS--May 29, 1969

Within the past year hard-core members of the Stanford administration have repeatedly defended the absence of new programs as the result of a shortage of funds. Because we on the People's Subcommittee on Investigations consider free access to information prerequisite to the democratic functioning of the University, we have prepared this report. Part I deals with the current use of funds within the University--explicitly the allocations for salaries.
