WE CAME - THEY RAN - WHY?

SDS is holding a rally Thursday at noon to go more deeply into the main issue that motivated us to confront the Trustees on Tuesday, to attain an open meeting at the price of good manners. The issue is Stanford's active involvement in perpetrating military, economic, and cultural violence in Southeast Asia.

We will describe more fully how Stanford Trustees have used the University and its economic and human resources to this violent purpose, and how faculty have involved themselves (knowingly or unknowingly) in research that facilitates destruction and social manipulation.

Further background and documentation of the demands which we are making will also be given.

Petitions and educational documents will be distributed, and resources for extending education on the issues into the dormitories and departments will be available.
