- Obstructing the free movement of any employee of STANFORD 2. RESEARCH INSTITUTE or of any other person in entering and leaving the buildings and properties owned or occupied by STANFORD RESEARCH INSTITUTE.
- Throwing or causing any object to be hurled at or struck against, 3. or marking, defacing or injuring, by paint or any other means, any property owned or occupied by plaintiff.
