FOR MONTHS THIS COMMUNITY HAS STRUGGLED TO CONVINCE THE TRUSTEES THAT SRI MUST CEASE WAR-RELATED RESEARCH. PETITIONS, REFERENDUMS, PICKETS, BOYCOTT, SIT-INS AND RESOLUTIONS SHOWED THE STRENGTH OF COMMUNITY SENTIMENT ON THIS ISSUE.

HOW DID THE TRUSTEES RESPOND? THEY ISSUED AN ARROGANT STATEMENT MAY 13 THAT THEY WOULD "TERMINATE" ALL TIES BETWEEN STANFORD AND SRI, PROBABLY THROUGH SALE TO A CORPORATION OF THEIR CHOOSING. LARGE COUNTERINSURGENCY AND OTHER WAR-RELATED CONTRACTS WILL CONTINUE UNTOUCHED.

WE HAVE NO RECOURSE BUT TO ACT DIRECTLY ON OUR CONVICTIONS.
WE MUST STOP THE LETHAL RESEARCH. WE MUST CONVINCE THE POTENTIAL
BUYERS OF SRI THAT THE TRUSTEES' DECISION IS ILLEGITIMATE AND
VOID. WE MUST BREAK THROUGH THE MORAL BLINDNESS OF THOSE
RESEARCHERS WHO CONTRIBUTE TO AMERICAN IMPERIALISM.

SRI'S OFFICE ON HANOVER STREET HAS LONG BEEN A CENTER FOR COUNTERINSURGENCY RESEARCH. THE APRIL 3rd MOVEMENT HAS VOTED TO BEGIN A SUSTAINED EFFORT TO STOP RESEARCH THERE BY OUR PRESENCE AND OUR ACTIONS. AS LONG AS WE ARE THERE, THE ABILITY OF THE MILITARY-INDUSTRIAL-UNIVERSITY COMPLEX TO MAKE FUTURE WARS WILL BE MATERIALLY REDUCED.
