## RSSC - Regional Security Studies Center

The RSSC is located both in Menlo Park and in Bangkok, Thailand. The RSSC staff totals 28 with 19 presently working in Bangkok and 9 in Menlo Park. The research done at the RSSC is intended to reinforce and broaden the US military presence in Southeast Asia. Reports issued by the RSSC in 1968 include the following:

- 1) Elements of capability and a scenario for a possible conflict in Southern Thailand.
- 2) The evolution of successful counterinsurgency operations in Malaya.
- 3) Operational testing of wireless seismic ambush aids.
- 4) Insurgency in NE Thailand and smuggling and illegal entry across the Mekong River border.
- 5) Communist Terrorist logistics in Southern Thailand - A quantitative analysis.
- 6) The logistics system of the communist terrorist organization in Southern Thailand.

One 1969 RSSC contract which we know about is:

An analytical approach to the estimation of counterguerilla capabilities.

We have included below the extensions of the nine RSSC workers living in the area and working at SRI menlo Park and Hanover. Uses of the phone numbers include the following:

- 1) Calling and talking to these people, learning what they are doing, what their background is, etc. (Keep pad and pencil handy)
- 2) If you are unable to get through to these individuals and are blocked by secretaries, try to tie up the phones with repeated calls.
- 3) Girls can pretend to be longdistance operators, calling person to person, collect, and so on.
- 4) Never use your name because all calls are taped. When calling from home don't talk for more than a few moments to prevent tracing.
