from: THE APRIL 3 MOVEMENT

We voted unanimously at our meeting Tuesday night to make the following request of SRI President Charles Anderson:

All SRI employees should be allowed and encouraged to attend the closed circuit broadcast in Memorial Auditorium of the Trustees' hearing on Stanford and SRI. Furthermore, they should receive full pay on Wednesday, including the hours from 2:00p.m. to 5:45.

In our letter to Mr. Anderson, we stressed our feeling that the hearings had been set up in an undemocratic fashion, with administrations of both institutions taking authority to decide what points of view might be represented. In the case of SRI, we regret that the employees were not allowed to select delegates as spokesmen for them, so we have a situation where SRI administrators only will be speaking.

Nonetheless, we feel that at the very least SRI employees should be given the right to watch the hearing, as the final decision of the Stanford Board of Trustees will affect ~~your~~ jobs and lives.

We continue to stress that the University can change its funding priorities so to increase the scope of socially useful research possible for SRI people to do. We hope to discuss this with you in person, at SRI or Stanford. Please call 321-2300 x3114.
