

Motion to Hold Public Hearings Pursuant to Rule I  
of the Rules of Procedure

(Motion by Senator Mundt, seconded by Senator Jackson,  
and unanimously carried)

I move, pursuant to Rule I of the Permanent Subcommittee  
on Investigations, that approval be given to said Subcommittee  
to hold public hearings or executive sessions until January 31,  
1970, under the authority of Senate Resolution 26, 91st Congress,  
1st session, <sup>as amended Feb 17, 1969</sup> (as amended by Senate Resolution 99 agreed to  
February 25, 1969, in connection with the investigation of riots  
and civil and criminal disorders in cities, on college campuses  
and elsewhere, and to hear testimony to determine whether there  
are groups or organizations or individuals who are fostering,  
or whose purposes, aims and objectives include the fostering  
of such riots and civil and criminal disorders, and to ascertain  
their key personnel, aims and objectives, organizational  
structures and sources of funds, and all other facts relevant  
to the question whether additional legislation is necessary or  
appropriate to prevent the recurrence of such riots, civil  
and criminal disorders.
