TELEPHONE SURVEY : INK OPINION POLL Nathan Maccoby Ext. 2754

An opinion poll was conducted by telephone last night to an attempted 413 residents of San Mateo and Santa Clara counties. The names were chosen by estimating the approximate number of names in the phone books and calling every th number. Of the 413 attempted calls:

68 did not respond
42 refused to answer
76 had no opinion
23 had not heard of the invasion of Cambodia

227 did have an opinion. Of these:

100 supported the move into Cambodia (44%)
127 opposed the ~~wa~~ move into Cambodia (56%)

The respondents were asked:

- 1) Have you heard about President Nixon's decision to send American troops into Cambodia?
- 2) Are you for or against sending U.S. troops into Cambodia?

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3) Why? (synopsis of reason)

Reasons for or against the move into Cambodia had not yet been analysed at the time of publication of this news-sheet.
