

THE COOPER - CHURCH AMENDMENT

The Foreign Military Sales act is amended by adding to end thereof:
(Amending Section 7)

Sec. 4-7 Prohibition of Assistance to Cambodia

In order to avoid the involvement of the U.S. in a wider war in Indo-China and expedite the withdrawal of American forces from Vietnam, it is hereby provided that unless specifically authorized by law hereafter enacted no funds authorized or appropriated pursuant to this act or any other law may be expended for the purpose of:

1. Retaining U.S. ground forces in Cambodia.
2. Paying compensation or allowances of or otherwise supporting directly or indirectly any person in Cambodia who: (a) furnishes military instruction to Cambodian forces or (b) engages in any combat activity in support of Cambodian forces.
3. Entering into or carrying out any contact or agreement to provide military instruction in Cambodia or persons to engage in any combat activity in support of Cambodian forces.
4. Supporting any combat activity in the air above Cambodia by U.S. air forces except the interdiction of enemy supplies or personnel using Cambodian territory for attacks against or access into South Vietnam.
