PACC (the Political Action Coordinating Committee) was formed on May 5, 1970, with a nucleus of 500 undergraduate and graduate students from Stanford University. In one week, the group grew to over 2000 students, faculty and staff working on some 50 separate projects. The goal of these constructive action groups is to reunite the University community and the surrounding community in a critical examination of this nation's military involvement in SouthEast Asia. We hope that our efforts will result in the permanent creation of a broad based politically and socially active community of concerned citizens.

A few of our many activities already in progress will exemplify our actions:

- 1. One group is involved with providing informed, responsible speakers to lead discussions with the members of various church, business and professional organizations throughout the area.
- 2. Other students have been trying to re-establish meaningful, human contact with the local police—in an effort for each group to better understand that there are real people behind the uniforms and inside the University. Students are riding with police in squad cars, while officers are having dinner in the dorms.
- 3. Some of us are engaged in a door-to-door canvassing of the Palo Alto community to encourage the sending of telegrams to Washington in protest of the continued SouthEast Asia war.
- 4. Groups are also making contact with alumni to inform them about how students feel about the issues which concern this campus. We hope to get both financial support for our activities, as well as their commitment to encourage the Stanford administration to be more responsive to these national and local issues.
- 5. In addition, some groups are engaged in research (public opinion polls, analysis of political speeches, etc.); others are working with high school organizations, and some are aiding political campaigns of local and state politicians.
