They - the trustees - brought the violence to Stanford - after the faculty voted against ROTC credit.

David Packard, ex-trustee, personally brought pressure to bear on the Stanford administration to reverse the faculty vote on ROTC credit. (David Packard was worth 300 million when he left Stanford to take over the number 2 spot in the Pentagon: now he is worth 360 million. But there is no money for workers!)

We, as Stanford employees against the war, express strong support for the students and faculty in the strike against the continuing and fast-expanding war in Southeast Asia. But, unlike them, we will lose pay or even our jobs if we participate in the strike.

BUT WE WILL NOT BE INTIMIDATED. We demand that there be no docking of pay either directly, or indirectly through sick leave or vacation pay for joining in the strike. We demand that the U.S. withdraw from Southeast Asia. We call upon students and faculty to support our demands so that we may join with them in this strike.
