

ROTC's future being studied June 1969

A faculty-student committee has been appointed by President Pitzer to advise him on the future of the Reserve Officer Training Corps at Stanford.

In May, the faculty voted to end academic credit for military training and education, starting with freshmen entering in 1970, and Pit-

zer said he would consult with the Department of Defense toward an appropriate non-credit ROTC program.

In appointing the committee, whose chairman is Prof. Alan S. Manne, Pitzer said he expected negotiations with the military services to continue through the summer and fall.
