

Last week 2700 Stanford students voted in solidarity with the peoples of the world to eliminate ROTC from this campus. The people most oppressed by ROTC (peoples of Southeast Asia and men drafted into the U.S. military) had no opportunity to participate in this vote. The officer class is maintained and genocide in Southeast Asia continues.

We demand:

We believe that Pitzer is being given more than enough time to reach a decision on these demands. If our demands are not met by Thursday noon we will engage in further action to eliminate ROTC.
