

PITZER RAPES THE JUDICIAL CHARTER (AGAIN)

The Stanford community has heard Kenneth Pitzer, President of the University and lackey of the military, refer all too often to the Judicial Charter of 1968 and to our judicial mechanisms. We have also seen him abrogate that charter and its mechanisms repeatedly. Now he has made a new rule without following the provisions of the charter.

The charter says that in an emergency he may make a regulation, provided that he shall first consult with as many members of the Student Conduct Legislature Council (SCLC) as practicable. He did not. The chairman of SCLC and many of its members were home last night, but were never contacted.

Pitzer's rule is invalid and cannot be upheld by the Judicial Council. I plan to spend as much of my free time as possible in the ROTC building to show my defiance and contempt for that illegal regulation. I only hope that those who plan to bomb or burn the building will give me ample warning so I can get out in time.
