

CONTEMPT!

Five well-known members of the movement to eliminate ROTC at Stanford are being ordered to show cause why they should not be held in contempt of a superior court order banning "disruptions" at Stanford. The five--Mike Sweeney, Janet Weiss, John Shoch, Lenny Siegel, and Art Busse--are charged with a variety of activities such as attendance at the April 3 Academic Council meeting, milling-in at the offices of ROTC commander Stanley Ramey, and attending ROTC classes. These activities involved hundreds of people, but only five were charged. Their real "offense" has been to play an active and outspoken role in the Movement.

President Pitzer, the Board of Trustees, and the Department of Defense need ROTC. They will also go to great lengths to destroy the movement against ROTC. To defeat the injunction we must respond by increasing our efforts to throw the military off campus.

MONDAY NOON, April 13, the Movement will RALLY in White Plaza to hear the response of Stanford Trustees to invitations to meet with the community to discuss ROTC. The contempt proceedings are a part of that response. Come to the rally and show your CONTEMPT for ROTC and the War in Southeast Asia.
