- A HOUSING CRISIS --if students think its hard to find a place to live here, how do you think workers feel? Stanford University is directly responsible for the housing crisis Palo Alto now faces. For, at the same time that Stanford is ever expanding, building new units on campus and lessing out more land to industries in the Industrial Park, it has made absolutely no efforts to provide suitable housing for its employees—the people who have built Stanford. The 200 housing units which Stanford now proposes to build is hardly going to solve the problems of 7,000 employees. Let's stop this expansion. Think people, not profits!
 - PRESSION OF STANFORD WORKERS—though Stanford won't admit it, racism is prevalent here. Minority workers are consistently discriminated against in hiring and promotion. Why are so many Black and Chicano workers hired for the lowest paying jobe? Why are they hired to work for an hourly wage, thus deprived of most benefits? Women workers find that Stanford takes special advantage of them, too. At SIAC just recently, a black woman was passed up for promotion in favor of a less qualified white man. Most workers at Stanford receive less income every year, since Stanford's pay scale doesn't keep up with inflation—even though the trustees profits do.

MHY ?

The reason behind all this is that Stanford is run for Profit.

Students come here to receive a higher education, but academia is just a small aspect of this institution. At the same time that Stanford collects profits from the Industrial Park, Shopping Center, defense contracts and SIAC, it pretends that it is too broke to pay workers a decent wage. It is no surprise to us that \$90,000 has been stuck into prestigious new lights, instead of going towards our needs. After all, the same men that decide to go into Asia to protect and extend their profit—making, control the exploitation of workers back home.

a paternalistic institution. It is no honor to work or study under such conditions. Workers have already begun to organise. Even now Stanford is trying to subvert our efforts by intervening in the hearings of the NIRB (a government agency that dictates where and how workers may unionise) being held in San Francisco—too far away for any workers to attend. But we are growing stronger. Already there are groups such as the Workers Action Caucus, the Alianza Latina, and the Coalition. We need your support.
