

LAOS: UP THE DOWN ESCALATOR

Forced by the American people to fight a losing war in Cambodia, President Nixon has expanded the War in Laos with a massive invasion by Asian mercenaries under the continued cover of American saturation bombing.

In response to this latest escalation, a group of people opposed to the War--from various political perspectives and constituencies--have formed the Coalition Against the War in Indochina.

The purpose of the Coalition is to recreate the community of outrage that met the Cambodian invasion. Unless we actively oppose U.S. war policy, it has no limits--even nuclear weapons may be used.

WEDNESDAY AT NOON the Coalition will hold a rally in White Plaza to hear reports of the events in Laos and the rest of Indochina. As part of the rally we will construct a geodesic dome which will serve as an information center throughout this crisis.

The Coalition is asking members of the Stanford-Palo Alto community to form groups in their dorms or neighborhoods, departments or workplaces to discuss what we can do to oppose the War.

Friday at 4:00 pm in Tresidder, CAWI will hold an organizational meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to build a framework through information about the War can be disseminated and local activities can be coordinated.
