WARRANT FOR THE ARREST OF DAVID PACKARD

The people of the State of California, the United States of America, and the World to any Peace Officer:

Complaint on oath having this day been laid before us that the crime of setting or continuing policies, specificly defined and prohibited in the Army Field Manual of the Law of Land Warfare (No. 27-10), under which the following criminal acts have been perpetrated:

- 1) the massacre of civilian populations
- 2) torture and murder of prisoners
- 3) poisening of crop lands
- 4) reprisal destruction of villages
- 5) destruction of civilian food supplies
- 6) indescriminate killing in "free fire zones"

has been committed and accusing David Packard thereof, you are therefore commanded forthwith to arrest above named defendant and bring him before the people, or the most accessible magistrate who will accept jurisdiction.

The accused should also be warned that he may in addition be charged with crimes against humanity under the Nuremberg precedents and the Geneva Accords of 1949, to wit:

- i) waging aggressive war
- 2) use of inhumane and outlawed weapons
- 3) mass transfer of civilian populations
- 4) racial and cultural genocide
