

# PACKARD BEFORE CALLEY

David Packard, Deputy Secretary of Defense, is making an incursion into Palo Alto today. His purpose in coming is to assure his cronies in the Western Electronics Manufacturing Association that they have nothing to fear from Nixon's coming "full generation of Peace."

Packard has played a key role in developing the strategy of Vietnamization which was pronounced a success in last night's speech by Nixon, a strategy which is nothing short of genocide.

The life sentence received by William Calley for the premeditated murder of at least 22 Vietnamese civilians has brought forth a massive outcry. Although it is clear that Calley is guilty no one thinks that he should be scapegoated. Government policy makers must bear primary responsibility for U.S. War Crimes.

Our message to David Packard today is that war criminals will find no comfort in our community. The Vietnamese people are not are our enemies--those who make war on them are.

It is our intention to arrest David Packard for the war crimes he has carried out against the Indochinese peoples in our name.

We intend no violence against persons ( although Mr. Packard and his friends are steeped in violence)

We intend no destruction of property ( although loss of property is trivial in the face of the death and destruction in Indochina)

If attacked by the police, we reserve the right to defend ourselves as necessary)

DAVID PACKARD IS AFRAID TO RETURN TO THE CITY HE OWNS and instead he will be speaking tonight in San Francisco at the Hilton at 7:00.

We had planned to serve a warrant and arrest Packard for his war criminal activities when he spoke at the Western Electronics Manufacturers Association dinner at Rickey's Hyatt House in Palo Alto. We've heard of people running from the process server, but to move a dinner with 700 people on one day's notice from Palo Alto to the San Francisco Hilton is doing it up a bit. We'll be there anyway, and we hope those people in San Francisco and East Bay who agree that it should be "Packard before Calley" will be there too.
