

WHO IS THE REAL WAR CRIMINAL?

Right now Lt. William Calley is being used as a scapegoat for some real war criminals. The My Lai massacre was part of the U.S. strategy in Viet Nam, and Calley is taking the rap for the real criminals, the men who thought up that strategy, and who force the GI's to carry it out. David Packard, Under-Secretary for Defense, and former president of Hewlett-Packard is one of those men.

Packard, who is worth \$300 million, made his money off the build up of the Defense Department, which he now helps to run. Packard's company produces the kind of electronic devices needed to carry on the war in Indochina. He was also on the Board of Trustees of Stanford University, and he was one of the men who thought up the idea of the Stanford Industrial Park, in order to use the university to serve the electronics industry.

Packard is going to be talking to the Western Electronics Manufacturers Association. While people all over this country are losing their jobs (20,000 people are out of work right now) these are the men who are moving their shops to Asia.

THE VIETNAMESE WON'T WORK IN RUNNAWAY SHOPS

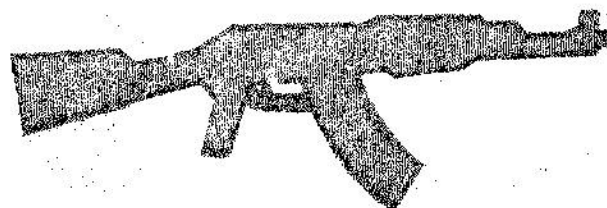
As Undersecretary of Defense, Packard understands that the U.S. Army is the only thing that protects the U.S. Companies that are making millions off the cheap labor in Asia. The Vietnamese people are fighting to drive out the American companies that are ripping off their land. The Indochinese don't want to work in American companies, taking jobs away from people here. But men like Packard intend to use every weapon of war, to commit every war crime to prevent the Indochinese from running their own countries. We are paying taxes and sending our brothers and sons over to Vietnam so that men like Packard can take our jobs away here at home, and make still more millions off the labor of the Asians.

We say that Packard is a war criminal not only because of what he orders done in Vietnam, but also because of the thousands of people who are out of work because of his policies, the "overtrained" engineers who are committing suicide because they can't find work, the 50,000 dead GI's, the hundreds of people in jail in this country who have resisted this war. Right now 73% of the American people want out of Vietnam now. Nixon and Packard want them in. The time has come for us to move on these war criminals and make the majority opinion felt.

We cannot let them get away with making Calley their Scapegoat. We must move to see justice done, and help our Vietnamese brothers and sisters keep runaway shops out of Asia.
