WHO 15 DAVID PACKARD?

David Packard is America's Deputy Secretary of Defense. His job, as Secretary Laird's chief aide, gives him major administrative responsibility for the Department of Defense (DOD), especially in relationship to industry and research institutions. He was the prime mover of the "Safeguard" ABM. He makes decisions involving the development of major "Safeguard" ABM. He makes decisions involving the development of major new weapons systems. Since America's war on Indochina today relies more and more upon aircraft and advanced electronic systems, his work is directly related to the war.

Packard's contribution to the U.S. war effort began long before he was appointed to his present job in 1969. He was founder and Board Chairman (with an annual income of \$1,000,000) of Hewlett-Packard, the world's largest manufacturer of electronic testing equipment, and which world's largest manufacturer of electronic testing equipment, and which does half of its domestic work with the government (chiefly DOD) or its contractors. Though H-P rarely designs a system or piece of equipment contractors. Though H-P rarely designs a system or piece of equipment specifically for the war, H-P supplies parts used in various forms of weaponry, such as diodes for proximity fuses.

Packard has served as a director of many other DOD contractors, notably Stanford University (he was Board Chairman for 3 years), SRI, General Dynamics, the Systems Development Corporation, Varian Associates, and U.S. Steel. He has also served as a director of PG&E, the Hoover and U.S. Steel. He has also served as a director of PG&E, the Hoover Institution (advisory board), National Airlines, Crocker-Citizens Bank, and Equitable Life Assurance--to name a few.

He has participated in a number of business associations, including the California Chamber of Commerce, the Bay Area Council, the Business Council, and the Urban Coalition (whose PR does not match its accomplishments). He was a director of the National Merit Scholarship Corporation and formerly was President of the Palo Alto School Board. He is very rice

WHAT IS A GENERATION OF PEACE?

To Packard and his mentor, the Wicked Dick of the East, the slogan "A Generation of Peace" means a Pax Americana, in which the middle class (and upper class) of America is insulated from the brutality that its rulers perpetrate.
