VIETNAM COMES HOME

On Wednesday, January 20, the Association of Old Crows (remember the electronic warfare vultures from Stanford's Applied Electronics Laboratory?) are having a secret meeting in the International Center of the Stanford Research Institute. This will be no ordinary secret meeting. The speaker will be Col. Gary Willard (Air Force), and he will be talking about "Wild Weasels--Their Mission, Problems, and Deficiencies."

Wild Weasels are about as predatory as Old Crows. They are planes armed with special electronic gear which makes possible the operation of radar-homing missiles. In the last ten days they have been used in at least six bombing assaults against anti-aircraft missile sites in North Vietnam.

Many people have been wondering what they can do to protest the bombings of North Vietnam. Others have been wondering whether SRI and other local electronics wizards still have an important role in the U.S. war effort and what they can do to end that role. Here is a chance to do both.

There will be a demonstration at the International Building of SRI on Ravenswood Road (near Middlefield) in Menlo Park at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, January 20. Let Nixon know that the American people will not let his new escalations happen without retaliation. Let SRI know that we will not tolerate their vicious war research in our community.
