Three to four hundred people attended a strike meeting in White Plaza Sunday Afternoon. After a confusing debate in which speakers offered several conflicting definitions of "strike," a majority of those voting voted to ask people not to attend classes or work Monday.

Most people did not consider this a clear mandate for a continuing class boycott, but the meeting decided to ENCOURAGE PEOPLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANTI-WAR ACTIVITIES DURING NORMAL CLASS HOURS.

THE MEETING DID DECIDE OVERWHELMINGLY TO CONTINUE OUR ANTI-WAR OFFENSIVE INDEFINITELY. The following events were scheduled for Monday, April 24:
