HOW TO STRIKE CLASSES AND BLOCK DOORS

There are various ways to stop entry to a building:

- Informational pickets: talk to everyone coming to the building. The goal is to persuade people not to go into a building and indicate why we are striking and blocking the entry.
- 2. Sit-in at doorways: In order to enter the building a person must walk OVER people sitting in. It is necessary to have strikers greet people coming to the building and explain why we are striking and blocking doorways.
- 3. Strikers linking arms: a person must break through strikers with locked arms in order to get into the building. It is important to have strikers greeting people interested in going into building. Greeter give out information and tell why we are striking and blocking the building.

Interfering with classes:

- Speakers go into class and ask class if they can present why we should strike. A discussion on the war and striking should take place.
- Guerilla theater in a class to dramatize the war and Stanford's direct complicity with it.
- Choose the techniques you feel best participating in.

 These are working suggestions. At some buildings a combination of techniques will be used; at other ones, use the best technique given the numbers of people working at any particular class.
