It is noted that while previously attached to the faculty at Stanford University, Palo Alto, California, as an Associate Professor of English, he was an active participant in the Stanford Committee for Peace in Vietnam and also engaged in protest demonstrations against the manufacture of the chemical napalm by the United Technology Center, Sunnyvale and Redwood City, California. FRANKLIN further made statements indicating his disaffection with the U.S. Government and when he resigned his commission in the U.S. Air Force Reserve, he stated that he wished to have as little connection as possible with the armed forces of the United States.
