FRANKLIN's latest book entitled FROM THE MOVEMENT TOWARD
REVOLUTION.

The enclosed book was purchased at the Stanford
University Book Store, Stanford, California, on 1/2/72, the
earliest time the book was made available.

The book was published in 1971 by Van Nostrand
Reinhold Company, 450 West 33rd Street, New York, New York.
It has been assigned Library of Congress Catalog Card Number
71-155954.

FRANKLIN, a member of the central committee of
Venceremos, is a tenured faculty member of Stanford University,
presently suspended at full pay. Extensive hearings were held
by an advisory board to determine if FRANKLIN should be fired.
The decision of the board, if reached, has not been made
public. The Bureau will be immediately advised of the
decision of the board when it is made known.
