Enclosed for New Haven is a copy of the House Committee on Internal Security (HCIS) Report No. 92-1166, entitled "America's Maoists, The Revolutionary Union, The Venceremos Organization."

It appears that subject is identical to person who is coming to Wesleyen University, Middletown, Connecticut, as a guest lecturer.

The 2/13/74 issue of the "Stanfford Daily" contained an article captioned "Franklin Takes Post at Eastern College" which stated that Franklin planned to accept an offer from Wesleyan University to be a visiting fellow at its Center for the Humanities for the Autumn of 1974 term. In the article, Hayden White, Director of the Wesleyan Center, acknowledged that officials at Wesleyan were aware of Franklin's disciplinary record at Stanford but that fact did not figure prominently in their consideration of his nomination for the position.
