

COMMUNITY MEETING 4:00 Friday Dinklespiel

Thursday 700 members of the Stanford community rallied to discuss taking actions in order to prevent Bruce Franklin's proposed dismissal--to begin to "rehabilitate" Stanford. A march which toured some of Stanford's war research facilities ended at Lyman's office where any possibility of discussion between administration and community people was prevented as doors were quickly locked and shades drawn.

There is a scheduled meeting of the Academic Council which Lyman is scheduled to address at 4:15 in Dinklespiel. We consider this a community meeting to discuss the escalating political repression of the anti-war movement at Stanford, this repression reaching a new level with the purging of Bruce Franklin. Lyman and the Academic Council may decide not to appear; with or without them, our meeting will go on.
