ON FRIDAY MORNING WE'RE MARCHING ON MOFFETT FIELD! THURSDAY AT LUNCHTIME- MARCH THRU THE ELLIS ST. INDUSTRIAL PARK.

WHO ARE WE? We're students and unemployed workers. Unlike the people who work in this industrial park, we have the time to demonstrate against the imperialist war in Southeast Asia. We know that there are limits to this kind of action—we won't be able to really stop the Moffett naval war machine, but we will be able to focus people's attention on the role the Navy is playing in the bombing and mining of Southeast Asia.

That's the part we have always played in the struggle against the war. Students have the time and the libraries of books needed to discover the truth about U.S. activities in Southeast Asia and elsewhere. Everyone knows that Nixon and his kind in the government (don't forget LBJ!) have lied to us time and again about the war. We know that years of anti-war demonstrations have revealed some of the hidden truth. This information plus years of inflation and unemployment at home, and death and destruction in Southeast Asia, have convinced 3/4 of the American people that immediate withdrawal of all our troops and weapons from that area is the

quickest way to end the war and get the release of POW's.

WHO ARE WE DEMONSTRATING AGAINST? If traffic is slow on Friday morning, it's not because we oppose workers at Ellis Street or G.I.'s at Moffett. We know these people are forced, in order to survive, to work for war industries and for the military. We are demonstrating against the high brass at Moffett and the corporation executives on Ellis Street. These are the people who profit from the war. Companies like Fairchild, Raytheon and Lockheed are as much a roadblock to peace in Southeast Asia as the brass at Moffett.

THE PEOPLE CAN END THIS WAR. Workers in plants like those on Ellis Street and G.I.'s on bases like Moffett have the real power to end this war. The most powerful force for change in this country would be a United Front between students, who have time and access to information; unemployed people, who can demonstrate against our rulers in the streets; workers, who can stop production and hit the bosses where it hurts; and soldiers, who are turning their guns around. The United Front is building, and this demonstration is part of it.
