One of the stated aims of the escalation is to sever lines of transportation. If we are to bring the war home, we too should set about severing lines of transportation. Freeways were blocked in New Mexico and Colorado yesterday during rush hour. We propose to do the same here.

We see a prolonged Freeway slowdown as a tool of awareness. Every day, if we are successful, each commuter will know that he or she is late to work because of this form of protest against the war policy. Business will not be as normal. Lines of transportation will be significantly impeded; an element of the war will have been brought home.

The action is simple. Wake up at dawn, have a leisurely breakfast, smoke a joint if you like, and take a casual drive down the freeway. 45 MPH minimum if the man is around. More casual if he's not. Roll down your window and talk to friends as you drive by. Slow down so you can hear each other talk. As more and more take part in slowing down bayshore to a dead stop, the vibrations will become more joyous as we witness the machine slow down. We will experience the END ALL WAR Celebration as we start every day.

This is serious. People were participating in this action this morning at rush hour. We will be there again, and every day until bayshore is no longer an efficient line of transportation. Join us tomorrow. Begin the day with a freeway fuckup. We will enjoy seeing you with us. You will know us when you see us there.
