THERE ARE LIMITS TO WHAT OUR CONSCIENCE CAN BEAR

We make this non-violent protest against the presence of FMC on campus in an effort to slow down the machinery which makes possible an illegal and immoral war.

In addition to manufacturing armored vehicles, flamethrowers, and missiles, FMC produces the Beehive cluster bomb, a so-called "anti-personnel device" which shoots hundreds of steel darts over a wide area, killing and maiming indiscriminately. The darts are barbed, and almost impossible to extract from the flesh.

In a war which has killed more than a million civilians, in which more bombs have been dropped than in World War II, and in which flaming gasoline, white phosphorous, torture and deliberate starvation are common weapons, the Beehive is one of the cruelest weapons of all. There are limits to what our conscience can bear. We cannot let the Food Machinery Corporation go about its business here while we do nothing to protest.
